Day-to-Day Policies

Closed Campus Meals – Sorry, you can't go to McDonald's. You CAN, however, purchase meals, bring packed meals, or have a parent drop something off for you.

Wear appropriate rehearsal clothing – When you come to camp, you need to wear closed-toe shoes and clothing that you can move/dance in every day. See our **Rehearsal Bag Checklist** for more information.

Electronics in Rehearsal – Keep your phone or recording device in your rehearsal bag and leave all other electronics at home. There will be times you will be asked to record a vocal part or film a video, but unless asked, phones should stay off.

Only Water in Rehearsal – The only food or drink that is allowed in rehearsal is a water bottle with a lid that closes. There will be designated meal and snack times and igloos to refill water.

Respect Off-Limits Spaces – Stay with the group when you are at camp – do not explore the theatre. If it is not yours, do not touch it. Keep both feet on the floor.

G-Rated Language ONLY – If you would not hear a word in a Disney Movie, you should not use it at camp. This applies to ANY LANGUAGE that you are speaking at camp.

Chew Gum Elsewhere – Bring mints if you had too many onions at lunch.

Walk in the Building – Zoomies are for outside. We'll give you time to release energy. Please walk inside the Arts Center.
