Kids Who Care's Mask Policy

In a place where children are our business, we wearing a mask has been a powerful simple action providing the strongest protection for our students, families, and staff. Effective March, 7, 2022, masks will be **OPTIONAL** for all students and staff in the classroom – vaccinated and unvaccinated. We will continue to evaluate this practice as the session continues.

Vaccination Policy at Kids Who Care:

Kids Who Care requires a proof of COVID vaccination for anyone over the age of 18 who is working with our children or is teaching or volunteering for Kids Who Care. We understand that there may be those who are unable to take the vaccination due to medical or religious reasons. We will have an application process for potential exemption.

For those who are not vaccinated, we will look forward to working together again in the future and will continue to monitor our safety procedures during this time.
