Vocal Auditions

What to Prepare:

- Verse and chorus (16-32 bars) of a song from a musical.
- Sheet music, in the correct key, marked with your start and end place.

*Musicnotes.com is a great resource for finding sheet music AND changing the key if needed.

Acting Auditions

What to Prepare:

- One memorized 30-40 second monologue from a legitimate play OR one memorized 30-40 second published poem (for our younger performers).

Reserve your vocal and acting auditions in advance by calling 817-737-5437.

On audition day, arrive at 9:00am for a mandatory parent and performer meeting for all participants. Dance auditions begin after the meeting at 10:00am.
