Dance Auditions

- A short combination will be taught to all participants followed by an advanced combination for some dancers.
- Please wear clothes you can move in and closed toes shoes and if you own jazz shoes please bring them with you.

What to Prepare:

Vocal Auditions

- Verse and a chorus (16-32 bars) of a song from a musical
- Bring sheet music marked with your start and end place.
Musicnotes.com is a great resource for finding sheet music and changing the key if needed.

Acting Auditions

- One memorized 30-40 second monologue. If you are able, please select a monologue from a legitimate play.
- For our younger performers: one memorized 30-40 second published poem. (Shel Silverstein is always a great choice for elementary kids!)
